The achievements of CASS Group are well-recognised. In 2011, CASS Group celebrated its 30<sup>th</sup> Anniversary. The NSW Parliament passed a special motion to honour its work and achievements to serve the community. The Federal and State members also congratulated its accomplishments in the respective Parliaments on a number of occasions.



CASS Care provides a comprehensive range of community services and activities in a wide geographical area which currently covers Metropolitan Sydney and Wollongong. It serves the Chinese, Koreans, Indonesians, Vietnamese and other people in the general community as well. More than 2,400 families access its services and activities weekly.

### Promotion of Chinese Language & Culture

### Community Activities

- Providing regular activities and social gatherings for the Chinese, Koreans and Indonesians, including social dancing, environmental care, summer camps, excursions and youth groups.
- Celebration of traditional Chinese festivals – Chinese New Year, Dragon Boat Festival, Moon Festival, etc., in the form of gathering or excursions
- Interest classes – Chinese chess, line dancing, stamp collection, etc.
- Pandaroos Families – a group especially for families with adopted children from China, enabling both the children and their families to learn and understand Chinese culture

- Organising fundraising activities for charities
- Enhancing the community building capacity of the Chinese community and encouraging their participation in community affairs
